Find the value of prestressing force required to balance full dead load and half live load? Take  $e = 1/25$  of length of beam and profile of tendon is parabolic. [4, CO2]

Q2. A rectangular concrete beam 100mm×250mm spanning over 8m is prestressed by a straight cable carrying an effective prestressing force of 250kN located at an eccentricity of 40mm. If the beam supports a live load of 1.2 kN/m calculate [5, CO2]

i) Resultant stresses at the central cross section of the beam

ii) Find the magnitude of the prestressing force with an eccentricity of 40mm which can balance the stress due to dead load and live loads at the bottom fibre of the section at the centre of the span.
